# KITCHEN SCALE INSTRUCTION MANUAL



### **Getting started:**

- 1. Place 3 AAA batteries in scale. (not included)
- 2. Place scale on a firm, level surface.
- **3.** Gently press the scale by hand to turn on. (note: the scale automatically turns off after 2 minutes)

## **LED** display



_	Negative value	0	Zero weight
fľoz	Weight unit (fl'oz)	Ճ	Weight mode

ml	Weight unit (ml)	M	Milk mode

**ERR:** Indicates scale load has been exceeded. (max 5 kg. or 11 lb.)

LO: Indicates batteries must be replaced.

#### **Button Functions:**

**ZERO:** Press while an object is on the scale, to set its weight to zero.

**UNIT:** Cycles between the following modes with each press:

Weight (grams) – Water volume (ml) – Milk volume (ml) – Weight (ounces) – Water volume (fluid ounces) – Milk volume (fluid ounces)

## Measuring weight:

- **1.** Place object on scale. Weight is displayed in grams. (note: tap **UNIT** button 3 times to display weight in ounces)
- **2.** If using a container, place the container on the scale and press the **ZERO** button, then add the items to the container.

## Measuring liquid volume:

- 1. Put container on scale and press ZERO.
- **2.** Press the **UNIT** button until the desired volume measurement icon is displayed (water/milk, ml/ounces).
- 3. Add liquid to the container.

#### Care and Use
